About

Studio interns are instrumental to our success and we are always looking for talented students with strong work ethic, good initiative, and a warm personality. Our goal is to provide you with a real-world experience in a fun environment and foster skills for a career not limited to just photography, but digital artistry, CGI, project management, etc. During an internship at KP, we encourage any and all questions to help you get a better understanding of how a commercial multimedia studio functions.

As a small business, our studio operates much like a home, and we share responsibilities to keep the studio running smoothly both on set and behind-the-scenes. This document outlines the responsibilities and requirements for our internship program.

Role Summary

The primary role of the studio intern is to support the KP Photo project management team and photographers. Under the supervision of the studio manager, the studio intern will be asked to do a variety of tasks for both client service and to support the photographers. This is a paid internship. (Hooray!)

Essential Duties

- Support photographers on shoots (e.g., pull necessary equipment and props, prepare sets and lighting to photographer specifications, etc.)
- Make grocery runs, gather lunch orders, and coordinate pickups/deliveries
- Maintain studio common areas
- Set up and tear down sets and organize props
- On occasion, build sets, paint or search for props and locations
- Sitting and working with digital artists & CGI specialists (not required, but available as a learning opportunity if interested)



Our studio provides lunch for everyone during client shoot days, and we are fortunate to have an in-house chef prepare lunch on occasion. On days a chef is <u>not</u> in-house, interns handle lunch orders for the studio and will also help with lunch setup/teardown.

Length of Internship

The internship will last the duration of one college semester or one summer. The number of hours will vary (from 30-40 hours per week) based on each student's schedule and hours required by the college/university program.

Requirements

- Junior/senior level from accredited photography, visual communications, or similar program
- Interest in food, product, lifestyle photography, digital artistry, computer-generated imagery (CGI)
- Basic knowledge of studio lighting and Adobe Photoshop, Capture One preferred
- Excellent organizational skills and ability to multi-task
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds
- Professional demeanor in both appearance and in communication
- Live in Cleveland or willing to drive to Cleveland
- Full-time availability preferred
